

Morris County Probation Office Information
New process goes as follows:

- The Probation Officers receive PTI applications on a rotating basis. After their receipt of the completed PTI applications, they will use a form to generate the PTI order.
- The form will then be sent to MCPO for the AP to fill in the specific conditions, etc.
- The AP will send the PTI form on to the defense attorney. The defense attorney will review with the defendant and then email the PTI order back to the Probation Officer and the AP.
- I have instructed the APs to have good communication with the defense attorney when they have a case requiring the use of the fillable the form. And I also reminded them to be patient with both court staff and defense attorneys as we move through this new way of doing business.
- Crim. Div. Mgr. has advised that the applications and orders will be accepted without the defendant's signature as everything will be covered on the record, similar to how things have been proceeding in our virtual courts with pleas etc.
- This will be effective tomorrow 3/27/20.
